What is the Union Pacific Rail trail right now

- The Union Pacific Rail Trail is a 28 mile mostly unpaved trail between the Echo Reservoir State Park and Park City
- Connects Echo State Park, Coalville, Hoytsville, Wanship, Lower Silver Creek, Jordanelle Reservoir in Wasatch County and Park City
- Utah State Parks has owned and operated since 1992
- Has little revenue stream and not being enhanced

What could the Summit Scenic Byway Be

- Properly zoned economic development corridor to enhance tourism and resident experience
- Properly maintained arts, cultural heritage, recreation, tourism and commuter corridor
- True community connector between the unincorporated town of Echo, Silver Creek Canyon, Jordanelle area of Wastach County and Park City
- A way to recreate, connect to history and economically develop the corridor
- A viable component of trail connections between Summit, Morgan, Weber, Wasatch Counties, as well as Wyoming

Project Components

- 1. Masterplan effort: currently underway between Summit County and State Parks
 - Adopted accepted by Summit County
- 2. Intergovernmental Agreement for local control conditioned on state and local government commitments
 - Includes milestones for all to achieve
- 3. Funding decided and allocated to bring to conditioned asset standards
- 4. Local governments properly zone, provide governance for and fund the future vision of the Corridor

Actions and Budget

- State:
 - Commitment to fund improvements to bring an agreed upon standard
 - Intergovernmental conditional agreement to turn to local control
- Local:
 - Adopted and accepted masterplan
 - Jurisdictional control plan
 - Developed local funding stream for development and maintenance
- Budget:
 - An approximate \$10 million over-multi-year commitment to infrastructure improvement and final disposition
 - Local commitment for perpetual funding for development, maintenance and operations
