What is a haiku?

A haiku is traditionally a Japanese poem which is made up of three lines that do not rhyme. The most common type of haiku has a set number of syllables on each line:

Line 1 - 5 syllables

Line 2 - 7 syllables

Line 3 - 5 syllables

What is a syllable?

A syllable is a single unit of sound in spoken or written word. You can think of syllables like 'beats' in a word:

The word dog has 1 syllable
The word rabbit has 2 syllables

The word elephant has 3 syllables

CHALLENGE:

- Write a haiku about when lockdown is over using the traditional structure of 5 syllables on line 1, 7 syllables on line 2 and 5 syllables on line 3.
- You might want to write about what you are looking forward to about lockdown ending, how you think the world will have changed, or how you feel about what has happened.






